CLASSES

8 Dog Mid-Distance - approximately 24 miles per day. May run with 7 dogs.

6 Dog Mid-Distance - approximately 16 miles per day. May run with 5 dogs.

Trophy Class: Timed separately

- 2 dog skijor – may run one dog
- 4 dog class – must start and finish with a minimum of 3 dogs
- 6 dog class – must start and finish with a minimum of 5 dogs

MINIMUM PURSE - \$3200.00 – purse amount will be updated throughout the planning process

60% split between top four finishers for 8 dog class

40% split between top four finishers for 6 dog class

8 Dog Mid- \$70.00 6 Dog Mid - \$50.00 Trophy Class - \$40.00

First day of racing start order will be determined by race committee prior to Musher Dinner.

Second day of racing start order will be in the order of day one finish.

The race starts and ends at Peacock Meadows Sno-Park. Racers and Dogs will navigate a challenging course with considerable elevation gains and backcountry terrain. This course will challenge even the most experienced mushers. **SNO-PARK Permits ARE REQUIRED** and are available on line at www.parks.wa.gov/winter or you can buy one at the General Store or at the Sno-Park on race day. **Idaho and Oregon Sno-Park Permits are valid.**

This race is under a Special Use Permit contract from the USFS/Okanogan-Wenatchee NF and Washington State DNR.
